- 4. An artist statement (max 300 words)
- 5. A project proposal (max 300 words) outlining the work you wish to pursue while here.
- 6. A brief statement (max 300 words) outlining why you want to do the residency, and what would be the most significant aspect of it for you in relation to its beneficial impact on your artistic practice and career.
- 7. An **enclosed** written reference from a professional within the applicant's field of practice.
- 8. A cheque for £12.00 made out to Standpoint Futures.
