

The Hackney Road Sculpture Prize is an exciting competition to find a new and unique sculpture which will be included in regeneration plans for the Hackney Road. The sculpture will be placed in the heart of a new mixed-use development, providing over 1,000 new local jobs and over 200 new local homes. Leading London developer Regal Homes are keen for the new public realm to be inspiring and reflect this vibrant area's creativity. Competition entries must reflect the theme of 'Regeneration' and be suitable for display in an outside courtyard and able to withstand the weather.

The winning artist will see their work made and exhibited by Regal Homes on the site of the new development. The winning artist will also receive a cash prize of $\mathfrak{L}1,000$. The piece of work must therefore be site specific, reflect the theme of regeneration and be unique and original.


Application

Entrants will need to submit a sketch or model of their design and complete our competition entry form including a short biography (300 words max) about themselves, their work and their inspiration for this piece. Entry forms are available to download from.

Size/Materials

Maximum base size: 1.5m2
Maximum height: 2m high
The piece and materials must be suitable for outside display
The piece must be appropriate for all ages

Competition Rules

Entrants must be aged 18 and over Entrants must currently reside in the UK Designs must be for a new sculpture.

Work that has already been constructed will not be accepted. Entrants must present designs of their own origin and must hold the moral and intellectual copyright to the work and designs

Entrants must submit sketches, photos or models of work, not the actual piece

Entrants may submit up to 3 sculpture designs

Entries must be submitted by 5pm on Monday 31st August.

The selection panel will not consider work submitted after this deadline The judge's decision is final

A maximum of £2,500 will be set aside to commission the winning artist to make the sculpture.

Once a winner is selected, they will meet with the Directors of Regal Homes to discuss the inclusion of their sculpture within the scheme. All correspondence with the winning artist will be by email, unless specifically stated otherwise

IMPORTANT: If your work differs dramatically on completion from the designs submitted to the competition, Regal Homes retain the right to reject the piece and award the prize to another participating artist. The winning artist will retain the copyright of the design, but the sculpture will be owned by Regal Homes

Regal Homes retains the right to use photographs of the sculpture for the publicity and promotion of the competition and Regal Homes development or to sell the sculpture for profit
